1. Introduction

- 1.1. Skilling Limited (hereafter the "Company", "we," "our"), is responsible as 'controller' for the protection of privacy and the safeguarding of clients' personal and financial information pursuant the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR"). By opening a trading account with us, the client (hereinafter referred to as the " Client", you`, " your") hereby gives its consent to such collection, processing, storage and use of personal information by the Company as explained below.
- 1.2. For client protection and satisfaction, you should take time to carefully read this Policy as well as any other policies, additional documents and information available to you through our website prior to opening a trading account with us. By default, you must read, agree and accept all the General terms and conditions set out below, and any additional documents incorporated herein by reference before you establish a Business relationship with us (without modifications).
- 1.3. By accepting this Policy, you agree to be governed by the conditions that follow, as well as the applicable laws. We place cookies on your device to help improve this website. Some of these cookies are required, while others assist us in improving your experience by collecting data on how the site is used. Please see our privacy policy for more information on the cookies we use.

2. Why are Cookies useful

- 2.1. Cookies collect information about how visitors use the site, for instance which pages visitors go to most often, and if they get error messages from web pages. These cookies do not collect information which identifies a visitor and Skilling will not use cookies to collect personally identifiable information about you.

3. What type of Cookies we use

Our website uses the following cookie types to improve website user experience, to make this website work correctly and efficiently, to enable website security, and to provide us with information about the use of the website:

- 3.1. Necessary Cookies: Necessary cookies enable core functionality. The website cannot function properly without these cookies, and can only be disabled by changing your browser preferences.
- 3.2. Analytical Cookies: We use this cookie to help us to improve our website by collecting and reporting information on its usage such as the number of visits.
- 3.3. Social Sharing Cookies: We use some social sharing plugins, to allow you to share certain pages of our website on social media. These plugins place cookies so that you can correctly view how many times a page has been shared.
- 3.4. Other third-party cookies: We use this cookie which is set by other online services who run content on the page you are viewing, for example by third party analytics companies who monitor and analyse our web access.
- 3.5. Session cookies: We use this cookie to help store data only temporarily during a browsing session in order to allow normal use of the system and are deleted from your device when the browser is closed;

- 3.6. Persistent cookies: We use this cookie to help us to read data upon your use of our website, saved on your computer for a fixed period and are not deleted when the browser is closed. Such cookies are used where we need to know who you are for repeat visits, for example to allow us to store your preferences for the next time you login;
- 3.7. Statistics Cookies: We use this cookie to help us understand how visitors interact with our website by collecting and reporting information anonymously.
- 3.8. Marketing Cookies: We use this cookie to help us to track visitors across websites with the sole intention to display ads that are relevant and engaging for the individual user and thereby more valuable for publishers and third-party advertisers.
- 3.9. Google Analytics: We use this cookie to collect information about your use of the Services. Google Analytics collects information such as how often users access the Services, what pages they visit when they do so, etc. We use the information we get from Google Analytics only to improve our Services. Google Analytics collects the IP address assigned to you on the date you visit sites, and other identifiable personal information and/or data such as user name, location, number of visits onto the web-page among others remain anonymous. The Company does not merge the information collected through the use of Google Analytics with identifiable personal information and/or data. Google's ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits to this site is limited by the Google Analytics Terms of Use and the Google Privacy Policy.
